No SWD (5)/74/Pt/83 The Governor of Assam is pleased to make the following orders regulating (Recruitment and Promotion) to the Assam Social Welfare Service namely

- 1 (i) These orders may be called the Assam Social Welfare (Recruitment and Promotion) Service Orders, 1994)

Strength of the cadre 4 The strength of each cadre of the Service shall be such as may be determined and notified in the Official Gazette by the Government from time to time. The strength of the Cudres of the Service on the date of Commencement of these orders shall be as shown in Annexure-I Provided that the Governor may Keep in abeyance any post and when considered necessary.

Method of rectuitment and promo-

- 5 Recruitment to the cadre of the service shall be made the following manners --
 - (a) Vacancy of post in the eadre of Joint Director of Social Welfare which shall be selection posts, shall be filled up by promotion strictly on the Principle of merit-cum-seniority from the incumbents holding any one or more of posts of the eadres of Deputy Director of Social Welfare for at least 5 (five) years
 - (b) Vacancy of posts in the cadre, of Deputy Director of Social Welfare shall be filled up by promotion on the Principle of Seniority-cum-merit from the incumbent holding the post of District Social Welfare Officer, Superintendent Homes/Prison Welfare Officer/Principal Bal bhassan Principal VTRC/Vice Principal Jorhat Blind Institute, Jorhat/Probation Officer Liason Officer/CDPO (ICDS) having at least 8 (eight) of services in one or more of these posts

Home Principal Balbhawan VIKS Probation Officer PWO Division Officer Vice Brincipal Jorhan Blind Institute The cadre shall be filled up by direct recruitment through the Commission as per norms fixed jointly with Ministry of Welfare Concernment of India by the Social Welfare Department

General Procedure of promotion .

- 7 (1) Before the end of the year, the Government shall make an assessment of the likely number of Vacancies to be filled up by promotion in the next year in each cadre.
- 2) The appointing Authority shall then refer to the committee the following documents and information in respect of the occurs found eligible for promotion as per provision of these orders. The member of such referred officers shall be four times the mumber of wacancies, provided there are sufficient number of possible eligible for promotion, or the actual number of eligible officers, if the number o such officers are found less then the four times the vacancies as the case may be--
 - (a) Information about the number of vacancies:
 - (b) List of officers in order of authority cligible for promotion (separate list for promotion to different cadres shall be furnished) increasing the cadre to which the case of promotion is to be considered.
 - (c) Character rolls and personal files work who Officers listed; and
 - (d) Any order documents and information as may be considered necessary by the Appointing Authority or required by the Committee or the purpose of correct appraisal of the Cases

- 4) The selection shall be made on the principle of merit-cum-seniority in case of the cadre of Joint Director of Social Welfare, it being a selection post and seniority with due regard to meritain case of the cadre of Deputy Director of Social Welfare.
- The Committee after examination of the documents and considering all relevant information furnished by the Appointing Authority shall recommend to the Appointing Authority a list of Officers not executing double the probable number of vacancies in order of preference, found suitable for promotion. In case the Committee does not consider an officer suitable for promotion according to his seniority, it shall record the reasons thereof to the Appointing Authority together with the list.
- 6) The Appointing Authority shall consider the list, prepared by the Committee along with Character rolls and personal files of the employees consider principle as laid down in (4) above and approve the list, unless it considers any chance that may be absolutely necessary. In the Appointing-Authority consider it necessary to make any change in the list received from the Committee, it shall inform the committee of the changes proposed and after taking into account the comments, if any, of the Committee shall approve the list with such modification, it any, as may in its opinion, be just and proper.
- 7) The list approved by the Appointing Authority shall be forwarded by it to the commission together with the Character rolls and other relevant documents with a request to approve the list.
- 8) The Commission shall consider the list together with the character rolls and their relevant documents shall information as may be required by the Commission and obtain from the Appointing Authority. The Commission shall approve the list with modification, if any, as it considered just and proper and this list finalized by the Commission shall be the Selection List which shall remain valid for 12 calendar months from the date of finalization of the same by the Commission

Reservation

8 In all cases of appointment, there shall be reservation in favour of candidates belonging to the members of the S C /ST (both Plains and Hills) in accordance with the provisions of the Assam Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Iribes (Reservation of vacancies in Services and posts Act. 1978) and the Rules made thereunder, General orders in

candidates, as may be in force for the time being shall also be followed

Appoint ment 9 Subject to the provision of Para-& all appointments shall be made from the Select List in the order in which the names appears in the Select list.

Semonity

shall be according to the order in which one's name appeared in the selection lists. If one joints the appointment within 15 days from the date of receipt of the order or within the extended period which shall not in all exceed three months.

Relaxation

Where the Governor is satisfied that, the operation of any of the provisions of these orders has caused undue hardship in any particular case, he may dispence with or telax the requirement of that provision to such extent and subject to such condition as he may consider necessary for dealing with the case in just and suitable manner.

Provided that the case of any Government servant shall not be deals with in any manner, less favourable to him than that provided in there orders
