NO. AHE. 194/2010/56 : Government is pleased to accept the U.G.C's recommendation as contained in 3.4.1. The same is reproduced below :

" A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and master's level for the Schedule Caste/Scheduled Tribe/ Differently-abled (Physically and Visually differently-abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures."
